Fifty years of Israeli occupation in numbers

60% of West Bank is under full Israeli control

More than **100,000 hectares** of Palestinian land appropriated for settlement use

50,000 homes and structures have been demolished by Israel

600,000+ Israeli settlers live on occupied Palestinian land

Before 2005 **9,000+** Israeli settlers had lived in Gaza.

4.9+ million Palestinians face daily restrictions on their movement

Zero criminal investigations into **1,000+** torture complaints

Thousands of military orders imposed by Israel since 1967 imposing repressive measures against Palestinians

Up to **99%** of cases heard by Israeli military courts in West Bank end in conviction

Hundreds of millions of dollars' worth of settlement products exported each year

Since 1987, more than **10,200 Palestinians have been killed**, often unlawfully. In the same period, **more than 1,400 Israelis** have been killed by Palestinians.

Average Israeli consumption of water is at least **four times** that of Palestinians across the Occupied Territories

10 years of air, land and sea blockade of **Gaza Strip** where more than **2 million** people are trapped. The UN believes Gaza will become uninhabitable by **2020**

96% of water in Gaza is contaminated and unfit for consumption

Unemployment in the Occupied Palestinian Territories was **27 % in 2016**, compared to **12% in 1999**.

Key violations resulting from Israel's occupation:

- 1) Illegal settlement construction and expansion
- 2) Evictions and home demolitions
- 3) Forced displacement and forcible transfer
- 4) Restrictions on movement and collective punishment
- 5) Expropriation of natural resources
- 6) Restrictions on the right to family life and livelihood
- 7) Arbitrary arrests, administrative detention and unfair trials
- 8) Torture and other ill-treatment
- 9) Unlawful killings
- 10) Restrictions on free expression, association and assembly
